Welcome to **Middle School Concert Band**. Throughout the academic year, students will be involved in a wide range of differentiated activities that will conform to the NYS Learning Standards for the Arts and the National Standards for Arts Education. The instructional methods will be largely student-oriented, encouraging participation and higher-order thinking.

GOALS

- Students will be able to develop skills which are essential to creating and performing effectively in the Arts.
- Students will be able to develop an understanding and an appreciation for the Arts and their influence on our culture.
- Students will be able to generate and conceptualize artistic ideas and work.
- NOTE: The Anchor Standards (AS) are the same across all arts disciplines. However, each discipline's standards
 have discipline specific interpretations of the AS, called Enduring Understandings (EU). EUs guide the content of
 the Performance Indicators. Some Anchor Standards in some of the arts disciplines have more than one EU.

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

- Mask must be worn at all times

- Refrains from excessive talking during rehearsal/ labs
- Attends all mandatory dress rehearsals and concerts/ festivals (Majors, MIP, etc.)
- Instrument is in great playing condition
- Follows classroom rules, (which are clearly labeled in the front of the classroom).

B. Participation in Weekly Labs 25%

- Attends required amount of labs each quarter
- Displays evidence of practice
