6. Two (2) grade 4 students, have not been in school this year

Shelter Rock:

1. One (1) grade 5 student, has not been in school this year

Secondary School:

1. One (1) grade 7 student, last in school on Wednesday, September 1, 2021
2. One (1) grade 10 student, has not been in school this year
3. One (1) grade 11 student, has not been in school this year
4. One (1) grade 11 student, last in school Thursday, September 2, 2021

Please note that any individual who is deemed to be a close contact has been notified directly by the Nassau County Department of Health and/or District personnel - with further guidance.

Please be reminded that our protocols were designed to mitigate the risk of positive cases and our priority remains the health and safety of our students and staff. More specifically, the District requires that all students and faculty/staff maintain proper hand hygiene, complete the daily Cleared4Class health attestation, and wear the appropriate face mask. Furthermore, our staff will continue to conduct daily cleaning/sanitizing of our school building.
