The chart below illustrates different ways that you can accumulate points

Science Demonstration – End of May/Early June	8 points
DuPont Challenge	8 points
Attendance at a Science Lecture	6 points
Tutoring*	2 points per half hour
Science Research EXPO Night Volunteer	4 points
Science Research Symposium Night Volunteer	6 points
Science Research Symposium Night Presenter	6 points
Science Honor Society Induction Night Volunteer	6 points
Park/Beach cleanup (on your own)*	6 points
Attendance at Meetings	2 points
Science Community Service not listed	TBA

Half Year (End of Marking Period 3) Point Requirement: 20 Points

Full Year Point Requirement: 40 Points

If you do not meet the requirement of 40 points at the end of the school year you will be put on probation. As a result, you will need to make up these missing points by the end of the 2nd Marking Period of the following year. All appeals must be made to both the Science Honor Society Advisor and the Principal.

*Events that you complete on your own **must** have documentation indicating your name as well as the name, signature and contact information of a supervisor from the event. For example if you assist in a park cleanup at a local park, someone who works at the park should sign a paper indicating you did indeed help.
