Dear Parents,

We are pleased to announce that this year's Senior Prom will be held at The Mansion at Oyster Bay in Woodbury, NY on Saturday, April 6th, 2019. We encourage all seniors to attend this gala event of the Class of 2019.

The Class of 2019 invites all parents to attend *The Promenade*, an hour-long reception in the High School gymnasium prior to your child's departure for The Mansion at Oyster Bay.

Parents should plan on bringing their child to the high school gym entrance between 6:00 PM and 6:30 PM. A parent may accompany up to three students to the Promenade and must stay with the group at the Promenade until the students board the bus. Upon checking in at the school, students will be given a pass for the bus that will take them to The Mansion at Oyster Bay. No boarding passes will be issued after 6:45 PM.

Students will not be permitted to bring any snacks, refreshments, water bottles, etc. onto the buses.

At approximately 12:00 AM, upon return to the campus, students must be met by either a parent, a pre-arranged car service or, if a licensed driver, students may depart from the campus in their own car.

All seniors attending the prom with or without a guest must complete **Forms A and B**.

Seniors may invite a non-MHS sophomore, junior or senior; no freshman may attend the senior prom and a high school graduate must be under 21 in order to attend the Senior Prom. No exceptions will be made to this rule.

Seniors who invite a non-MHS high school guest (grades 10-12 only) or a high school graduate are required to have the following forms completed:

- For high school guests: **Forms A, B, & C**
- For guests who have graduated high school: **Forms A, B & D**

These completed forms must be submitted at the time of ticket purchase - no tickets can be purchased without them!

Tickets for the prom will be on sale in the main lobby of the high school outside of the **Senior Spa** on Thursday, March 21st and Friday, March 22nd during periods 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 (9:45 AM until 1:30 PM). No tickets will be available for sale after this time. **Please do not wait until the last minute to purchase a ticket.**

Ticket Purchase Guidelines:

- **Payment:** by check, cash or money order. **Each ticket is \$160.00.** Make your check or money order payable to “Manhasset GO”. No tickets will be sold the night of the event.
- **Financial Assistance:** Students needing financial assistance should notify their guidance counselor by Wednesday, March 20th.

The Senior Prom is a Manhasset High School sponsored event. As per the Secondary School Attendance Guidelines posted on the school website, **any student planning to attend the Senior Prom is required to be in school (all periods) during the day before the event in order to participate.** Additionally, all rules and regulations from The Manhasset School District Code of Conduct are in effect for the entire evening. Any violation of the district code will result in immediate disciplinary action at both the pre-prom, the prom site and upon return to school. For example, any student or guest who attends this event under the influence of alcohol or any other drug, or who possesses or imbibes alcohol or any other drug during the senior prom will be escorted from the event area to an office. An administrator will call the parent of the student and/or guest in violation of the code of conduct. However, the parents of both the student and guest will be requested to immediately pick up his or her child from the prom. As per Board of Education Policy 5445, any student suspected of consuming alcohol will be asked to use a breathalyzer. Failure to comply with a breathalyzer test automatically equates to violating our code of conduct. A grade level assembly will occur on Friday, April 5th to outline this policy as well as details of the evening. **The consequences for possession of and/or under the influence of alcohol or drugs at the prom are:**

1. **Three day out of school suspension, April 8th, 9th and 10th, 2019**
2. **Three week social suspension, April 8th – May 3rd, 2019**
3. **A 10th grade student will be prohibited from attending the 2020 Junior Prom and may not attend the 2020 Senior Prom as a guest**
4. **An 11th grade student will be prohibited from attending the 2020 Senior Prom and may not attend the 2019 Senior Frolic as a guest**
5. **A 12th grade student will be prohibited from attending the 2019 Senior Frolic**

We fully expect that *The Promenade* and the Senior Prom will be an enjoyable experience for all students. The class spirit and camaraderie has been a wonderful trademark of the Class of 2019. We look forward to this celebration of school and spirit, and we enthusiastically anticipate a wonderful evening for the senior class and its guests.

Acknowledgement of Having Read 1) the Manhasset Public Schools Board of Education Policy on *Students Drug and Alcohol Abuse*, Policy #5440, reproduced below, and 2) The High School Disciplinary Code of Conduct as found in the Manhasset Secondary School Planner, pages 18 & 19

This form is to be completed by 1) the MHS senior prom attendee and 2) the legal guardians or guardian of said senior. If applicable, both legal guardians must sign this acknowledgement form.

This signed form must be handed in at the time of ticket purchase.

Policy #5440:

“The Board of Education is committed to the prevention of alcohol and illegal substance use/abuse. The term illegal substances shall include, but not be limited to, inhalants, marijuana, cocaine, LDS, PCP, amphetamines, heroin, and steroids. This policy describes the philosophy of the District and the program elements the District will use to promote healthy life styles for its students and to inhibit the use/abuse of alcohol and other substances.

No student may possess, sell, or distribute or use, or be under the influences of alcohol and/or other illegal substances on school grounds, or at school sponsored events. Furthermore, no student may possess, sell, distribute, or use drug paraphernalia on school grounds or at school sponsored events.

Additionally, the following persons shall be prohibited from entering school grounds or school-sponsored events: any person exhibiting behavior, conduct, or personal or physical characteristics indicative of having used or consumed alcohol and/or other illegal substances, or any person whom school personnel have reasonable grounds to suspect has used alcohol and/or other substances.

In order to educate students on the dangers associated with alcohol and/or illegal substances on school grounds or during school-sponsored events shall report the incident immediately to the Building Principal or other appropriate staff members, who shall then take immediate action. Any alcohol or illegal substances found shall be confiscated immediately, followed by notification of the parent(s)/guardian(s) of the student(s) involved and the appropriate disciplinary action taken, up to and including suspension and referral for prosecution. In its effort to maintain an alcohol and illegal substance-free environment, the District shall cooperate to the fullest extent possible with local, state and/or federal law enforcement agencies.

The District will use the following principles as guides for the development of its substance use/abuse prevention efforts and for any disciplinary measures related to alcohol and other substances:

1. Alcohol and/or other substance use/abuse is preventable and treatable.
2. Alcohol and/or other substance use/abuse inhibit the District from carrying out its central mission of educating students.
3. The behavior of the Board, the administration, and all school staff should model the behavior asked of students.
4. While the District can and must assume a leadership role in alcohol and other substance use/abuse prevention, this goal will be accomplished only through collaborative, coordinated efforts with parents, students, staff, and the community as a whole.”
