
Join MyOn **5** in Easy Steps

Step 1

Open your MyOn account (MyOn can also be found on the elementary school webpages.) Log in: first_name_lastname only. PW = Your regular mufsd password.

Step 2

Click on the MyOn button.



Step 3*: Take the interest inventory and leveling assessment. (Or continue where you left off!)

*Because this is your first time signing in, you will be prompted to answer a few questions. These questions help determine your interests, comprehension, and reading level. You will not repeat this step next time you log in.
