



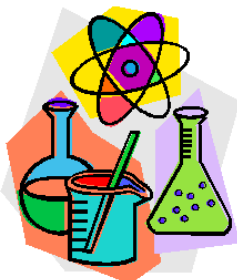

Registration Information

1. The program will be held at Shelter Rock Elementary School.
2. **Registration Fee: \$610.00 (bus service included in fee)**. A bus stop closest to your home will be assigned. The stop and time will be indicated on your child's Summer Center Program Card that is returned prior to the start of the program.
3. **Registration Deadline: Wednesday, May 31, 2017**.
4. **Late Fee: All registrations received after May 31, 2017 will incur a \$25.00 late fee.**
5. **Courses are listed for the grade level the student is entering in September 2017.**
6. Select the courses in which you would like to enroll your child. Course enrollments have limits and, therefore, will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. We will do our best to accommodate all selections.
7. Prepare a schedule for your child and complete the Program Card.
8. **Mail-In Registration:** Please fill out all information on the Registration Form & Program Card. Return the completed paperwork and enclose a check or money order payable to **SCOPE**. Credit cards are also accepted by completing the Credit Card Authorization Form. Mail to:

Classes will be offered in two sessions:

Session 1: July 3 - July 14

Session 2: July 17 - July 28

ARTS & CRAFTS COURSES:



- **ART AROUND THE WORLD: Grades 2-6: Session 1 Period 4**
