

To Access Your Student Account:

1. Go to www.castlelearning.com
2. Login ID: (your teacher will provide you with an ID or contact Castle Learning for your Log in info)
 - **NOTE:** Email cannot be used as an ID until a profile is created by the student with email address
3. Enter your Password and click the Sign In button
 - **NOTE: First Time Users:**
 - Skip the password field (**ONLY** if you are a first time user) and click the **Sign In** button
 - Follow the steps to create a password and set up your profile
 - Once logged in, the account is the same for all courses

To Complete Assignments From Your Teachers:

1. Notice **Incomplete Assignments** next to your teacher's name
2. Click on the teacher's name
3. Under the section **Incomplete Assignments**, click on the course
4. Click the blue date or assignment description

NOTE: You can review the vocabulary (Flash Cards) associated with the assignment by clicking the sun icon before starting the assignment.

To Create Assignments on Your Own:

1. From the middle of the Student Home Page, under the **Courses** section, select a course from a drop down menu and click **Go**
 - **Review** – similar to assignments teachers create
 - Click **Sessions That You Create Yourself**
 - Click **Create a New Short Answer Session** or **Create a New Session from the Other Units**

NOTE: **Create a New Short Answer Session From a Sample Assignment** are typically sample state exams or pre-planned unit/section assignments
 - Click the **+** next to the Unit then check the box next to the desired Section(s) to practice
 - Scroll to the bottom of the page and select **Number of Questions**
 - Click **Start the Session**

NOTE: If some questions are not applicable to your current level, you can skip a question by clicking on the next question number. Be sure to retry if you get a question wrong.
 - **Vocabulary Review** – look up vocabulary words alphabetically
 - **Skill Review** – Math Drills - available only with Math, Elementary and Intermediate Math Courses
 - **Flash Cards** – similar to vocabulary, except they are grouped by topic
