

Manhasset School District Reaches Agreements with its Bargaining Units

The Board of Education unanimously (5-0) approved the following agreements with each of the District's three bargaining units:

- A 4 year agreement with the Manhasset Education Association, the faculty, which began July 1, 2016 and continues through June 30, 2020. The Board took the action at its February 2, 2017 public session meeting.
- A 3 year agreement with the Manhasset Educational Support Personnel Association, our support staff, which began July 1, 2016 and continues through June 30, 2019. The Board took action at its December 22, 2016 meeting.
- A 4 year agreement with the Manhasset Administrators and Supervisors Association that began July 1, 2016 and continues through June 30, 2020. The Board took action at its December 22, 2016 meeting.

Board President Regina Rule stated "It is an honor to reach agreements with all our school personnel that afford continued stability in our schools and the unimpeded ability to focus on student learning and growth during these turbulent times in public education. The Board is grateful for everyone's commitment to teamwork and collaborative problem solving that was integral to these successful negotiations."

Key elements of the four year MEA agreement include:

- 0% increase in 2016-17, 0.75% increase in 2017-18, 1% increase in 2018-19 and 0.75% increase in 2019-20
- A 1% increase in the employee health insurance premium contribution in both 2017-18 and 2019-20 ending in a contribution of 24%.

Key elements of the three year MESPA agreement include:

- 0% increase effective July 1, 2016, 0.75% increase effective January 1, 2017, 0.75% increase in 2017-18, 0% increase in 2018-19 and a
- \$400 payment, not added to base salary, for unit members who are not increment eligible in 2018-19

Key elements of the four year MASA agreement:

- 2% increase in 2016-17, 2% increase in 2017-18, 1% increase in 2018-19, 1% increase in 2019-20

Carlo Prinzo, who has been a member of the board of education for the past eleven years, added "Given the retirement of Mr. Cardillo in June, these settled contracts enable our next superintendent to hit the ground ready to focus completely on the needs of our students."
