New York State Scholarships for Academic Excellence
Depending on the action of the New York State legislature, New York State will award this scholarship. Each high school is invited to submit the names of those students who meet the established criteria. The number of students nominated by each high school is determined by New York State and is based on enrollment. Of the two options, Manhasset uses the average of Regents scores achieved on the following exams: <i>English Language Arts, United States History Global Studies, Algebra 2, and 2 science exams</i> . (In the event of a tied score, a third science exam is used) If selected to receive this scholarship, the student must attend a college in New York Qualifying students will be notified in March, 2023.
Community Sponsored Scholarships For Manhasset Seniors (Presented at the Senior Award Ceremony)
Each year Manhasset High School seniors are awarded scholarships which are sponsored by families, civic organizations, community groups, and private businesses.
