3. Reaffirmation of Approval of Agreement with Educational Data Services, Inc. and Appointment of Cooperative Bidding Agent (Enclosure)

4. <u>Approval of Refuse Removal, Street Sweeping, Drainage System Maintenance Bid</u> <u>for 2020-2021</u>

WHEREAS, It is the plan of a number of public school districts in Nassau County, New York, to bid jointly on Refuse Removal, Street Sweeping and Drainage System Maintenance, and

WHEREAS, The Manhasset UFSD is desirous of participating with other school districts in Nassau County in the joint bidding of the commodities mentioned above as authorized by General Municipal Law, Section 119-0, and

WHEREAS, The Locust Valley Central School District wishes to appoint a committee to assume the responsibility for drafting of specifications, advertising for bids, accepting and opening bids, tabulating bids, reporting the results to the Boards of Education and making recommendations thereon, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Education of the Manhasset UFSD hereby appoints Locust Valley Central School District for Manhasset UFSD to represent it in all matters related above, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Manhasset UFSD Board of Education agrees to assume its equitable share of the costs of the cooperative bidding, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Manhasset UFSD Board of Education agrees (1) to abide by majority decisions of the participating districts on quality standards; (2) that unless all bids are rejected, it will award contracts according to the recommendations of the committee; (3) that after award of contract(s) it will conduct all negotiations directly with the successful bidder(s).
