




# District Demographics 2023-2024







#### Math Regents Passing Results




#### Math Regents Mastery Results




#### Humanities Regents Passing Results




#### **Humanities Regents Mastery Results**

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
### Requirements for a Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation






#### Middle School Music Enrollment




