Reopening Plan: Guiding Ideas

- Establish protocols to ensure the safe return of students and adults to the physical school buildings.
- Ensure that any instructional model that is proposed allows us to complete the entire breadth of the curriculum.
- Ensure equitable access to the curriculum, instruction and support.
- Ensure that the various instructional models allow for the fluid transition between a full return of all students to their school building, a Hybrid Model of Instruction (a combination of onsite instruction and remote instruction), and a fully Remote Instruction Model.

What we are considering: Option 1

Impact:

Use all available classrooms at Munsey Park.

Similar class size at both Shelter Rock and Munsey Park.

To achieve parity this model does not take advantage of the extra square footage in Shelter Rock classrooms.

Plus 10 teachers (approx. \$1 mil.)

100% in classrooms	50% in classroom; 50% onsite remote locations

What we are considering: Option 2

Impact:

Use all general education classroom space at both schools.

Take advantage of extra square footage in Shelter Rock classrooms resulting in different class size in Shelter Rock and Munsey Park (based on classroom square footage).

All Kindergarten students move to Shelter Rock.

Plus 10 teachers (approx. \$1 mil. - Same as option 1)

100% in classrooms	50% in classroom; 50% onsite remote locations

What we are considering: Option 3

Impact:

Use all available general education classroom space at both schools plus computer labs, art, science and music classrooms.

Balance class size in Shelter Rock and Munsey Park.

All Kindergarten students move to Shelter Rock.

7 additional teachers over option 1 and 2 (additional \$700,000)

100% in classrooms	50% in classroom; 50% onsite remote locations

Impact:


Use all available general education classroom space at both schools plus computer labs, art, science and music classrooms.

Balance class size in Shelter Rock and Munsey Park.

All Kindergarten students move to Shelter Rock plus 60 fifth grade students from Munsey Park.

7 additional teachers over option 1 and 2 (additional \$700,000) and 1 additional teacher over option 3 (additional \$100,000).
